



DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Collin on the 11th day of April, 2016, has suffered severe damage and loss of property resulting from an extreme severe weather and hail event in Collin County that has resulted in a significant disruption of commerce and transportation, as well as, local government services.


A severe weather event in Collin County, Texas has resulted in substantial loss of property and commerce. Many homes and businesses are significantly damaged, or destroyed. Residents and businesses may not be able to return for an extended period of time.

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Collin County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF COLLIN COUNTY:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the County of Collin pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Collin County.
3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Collin County emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
