

DECLARATION OF DISASTER PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City of Wylie on the 11th of April, 2016 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from a severe weather event including major hail damage to the City of Wylie area; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Wylie has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Wylie has the authority under §418.185 of the Texas Government Code, to evacuate an area stricken or threatened by a disaster and may compel persons to leave and use reasonable force to remove persons from the area; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WYLIE:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Wylie pursuant to §418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.

1. Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Wylie.
2. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
3. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City emergency management plan.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
