 - Funds on completed projects to be returned to contingency unless requested for another project.

 - \$311,951 budgeted and allocated on open space projects
 - \$1.0 million budgeted and allocated on facilities projects
- Funds remaining in completed projects to be returned to contingency unless requested for another project.
- \$1.6 million Remaining in Contingency for Road Projects
- \$2.26 million Remaining in Contingency for Parks & Open Space Projects

Debt Service Tax Rate Impact

- Certified Estimate Provided April 30, 2016
 - Net Taxable increase of 10.2% from last year's certified value
 - Adjusted Taxable value estimated to increase 9.3% from last year's certified value.
