Subject: Interlocal Agreement between Collin County and the City of Plano for the Design and Construction of Legacy Drive at Parkwood Blvd and Coit Rd between SH190 and Mapleshade Ln Intersection Improvements; 2007 Bond Project #07-058; Plano CIP #6610

The Engineering Department seeks approval and execution of the Interlocal Agreement between Collin County and the City of Plano for the Design and Construction of Legacy Drive at Parkwood Blvd and Coit Rd between SH190 and Mapleshade Lane Intersection Improvements; 2007 Bond Project #07-058.

This project provides intersection improvements at Legacy Drive at Parkwood Blvd and Coit Rd between SH190 and Mapleshade Lane. This project is under design and will go to construction next year.

The 2007 Collin County Bond program includes funds for half of the cost of the project. This ILA authorizes the County share of the project cost in the amount of \$1,323,722. We further seek Commissioners Court approval of the following budget adjustment from projects identified by the City of Plano:
