Commissioner Williams said the Committee, which includes District Attorney Greg Willis, Sheriff Jim Skinner, Judge John Roach representing the district courts, Judge Corrine Mason representing the county courts and the Commissioner met last week. Judge Roach was elected as the Chair and Sheriff Skinner as the Vice Chair. The Committee reviewed jail statistics provided by Sheriff Skinner and discussed magistration issues and issues surrounding inmates having contact with their attorneys in a timely fashion. The Sheriff will provide more specific information on these issues at the next meeting. Two subcommittees were created – a Jail Magistration Subcommittee and a Mental Health Jail Population Subcommittee. Commissioner Williams is on both of the subcommittees. The Jail Population Committee will meet again next month. (Time: 1:32 p.m.)
