Within 2 weeks after approval by Commissioners Court, a 9-1-1 address correction letter will be sent to you, your emergency service dispatcher, your post office, and the Collin Central Appraisal District. Upon receipt of the 9-1-1 address correction letter, you may begin using your new address for all mail correspondence. The Post Office will deliver mail addressed to your former address for approximately one year (12 months).

The County will provide a blue and white metal road sign and post. Signage repairs or replacements will be the responsibility of the adjoining property owners. Please contact the Collin County Sign Shop with questions about signage – 972-548-3715.

Please don't make any changes until you receive the change approval letter.
