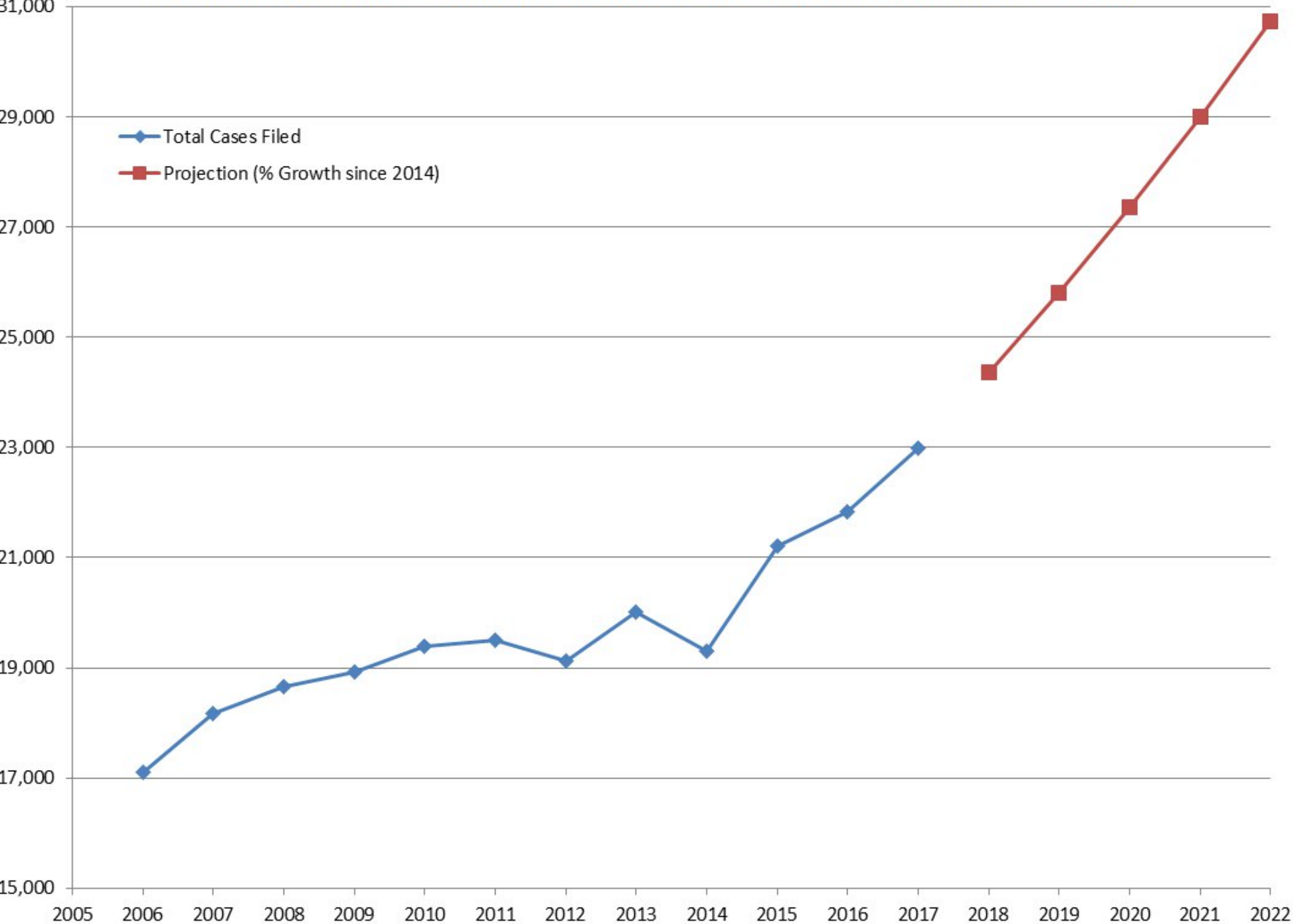
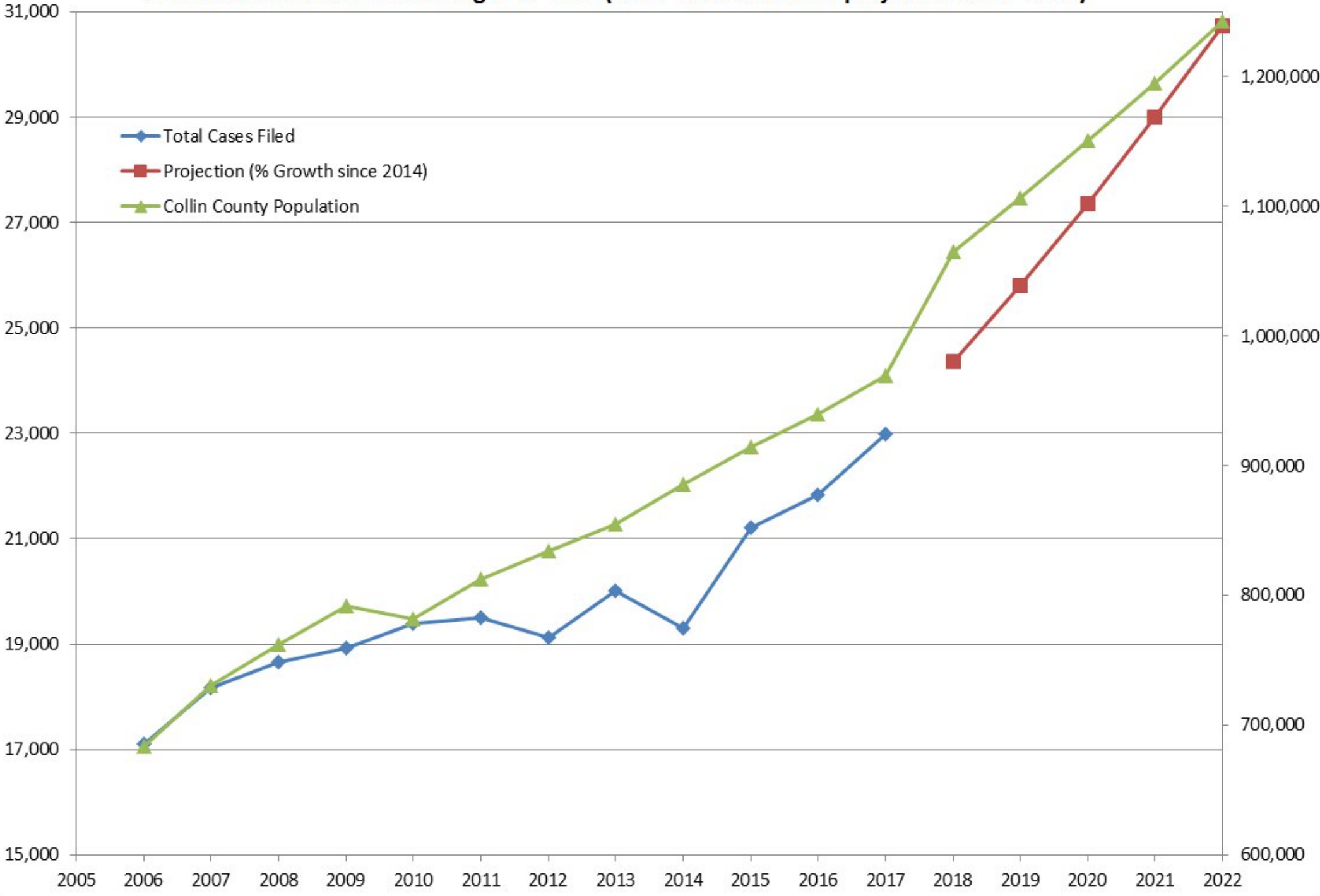


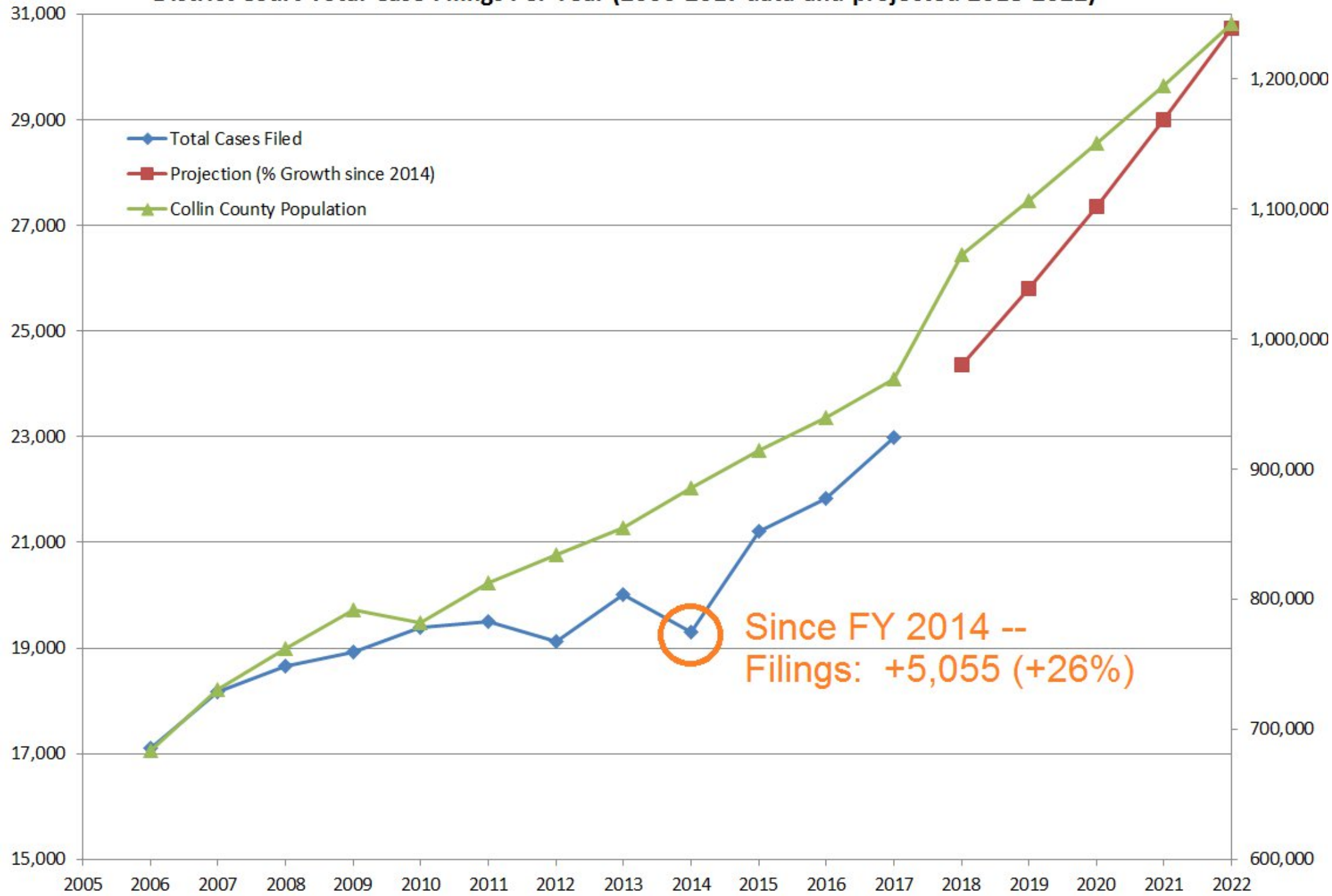
District Court Total Case Filings Per Year (2006-2017 data and projected 2018-2022)

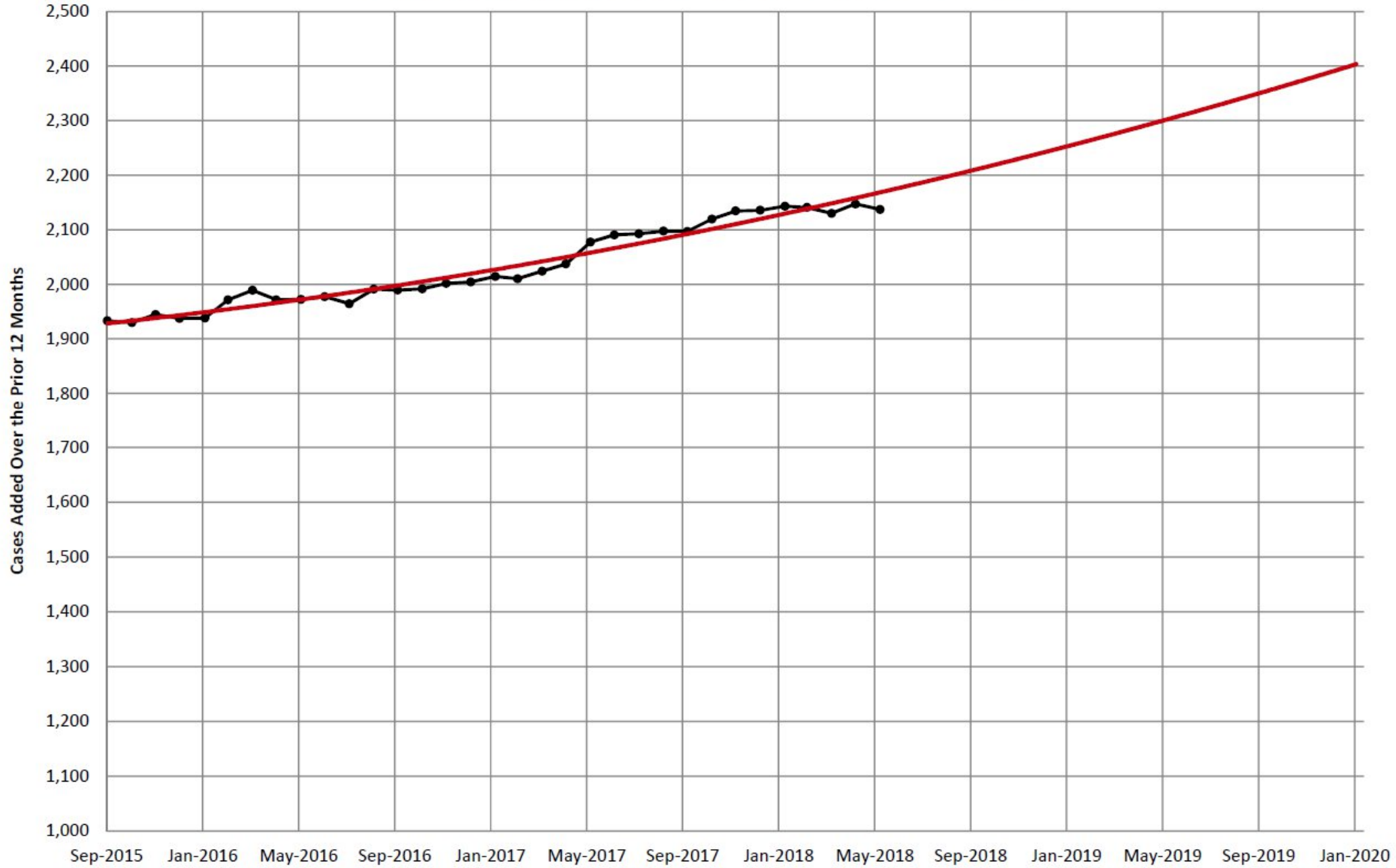

## **Average Minutes Available for Each Case (Based on Current Filings)**

23,621 cases were filed in Collin County District Courts from May 2017 – April 2018.

That's 2,147 per court.

This means each court must finalize 179 cases per month, or about **9 cases per day**, to keep even with new filings.

That means **each case is entitled to a total of 53 minutes of time**—on and off the bench.

So, for example, if a trial will take 3 days, that case is taking up 27 cases worth of court time.

(not including any time needed for reading pleadings, researching the law, preparing orders, etc)

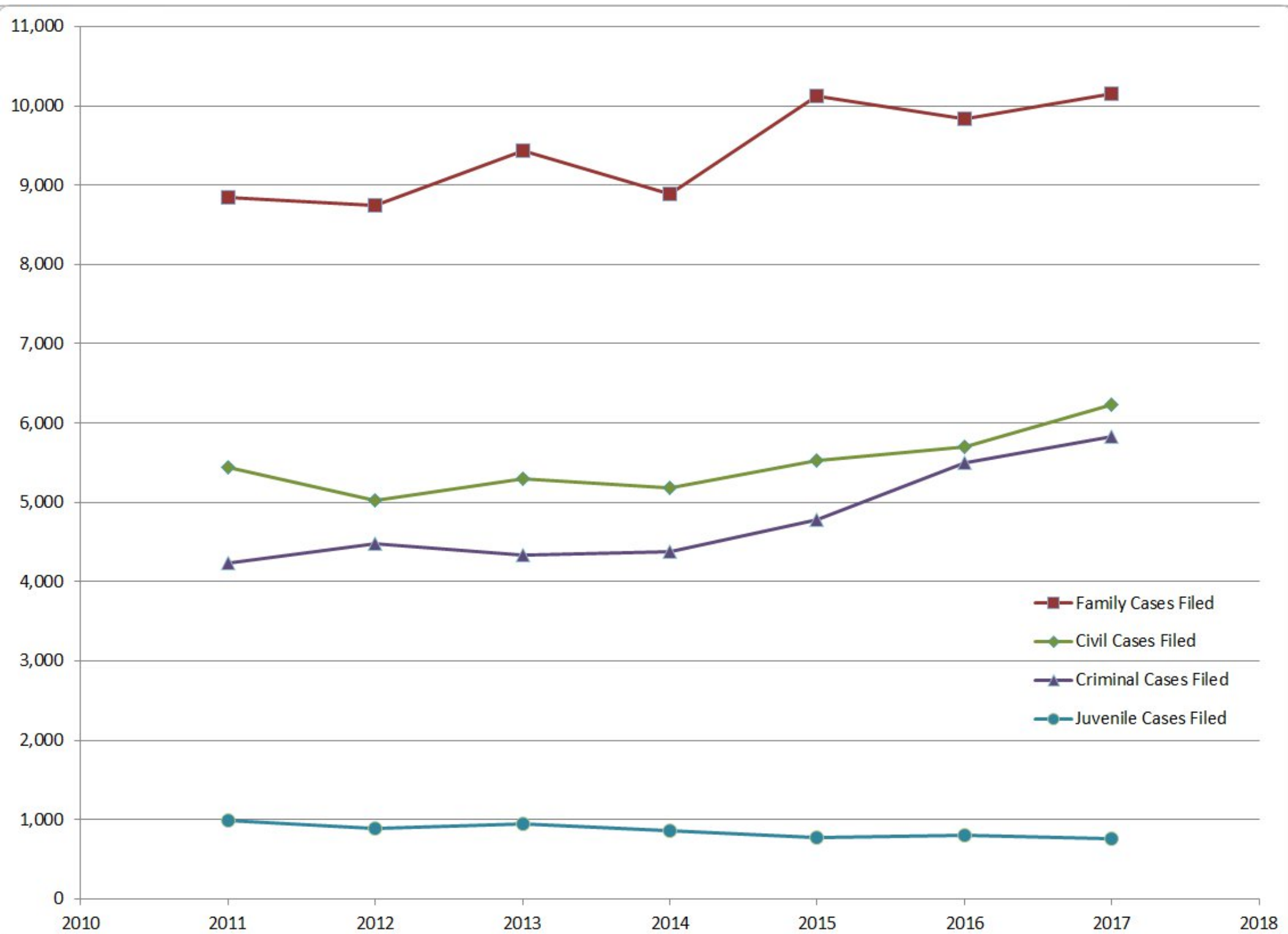

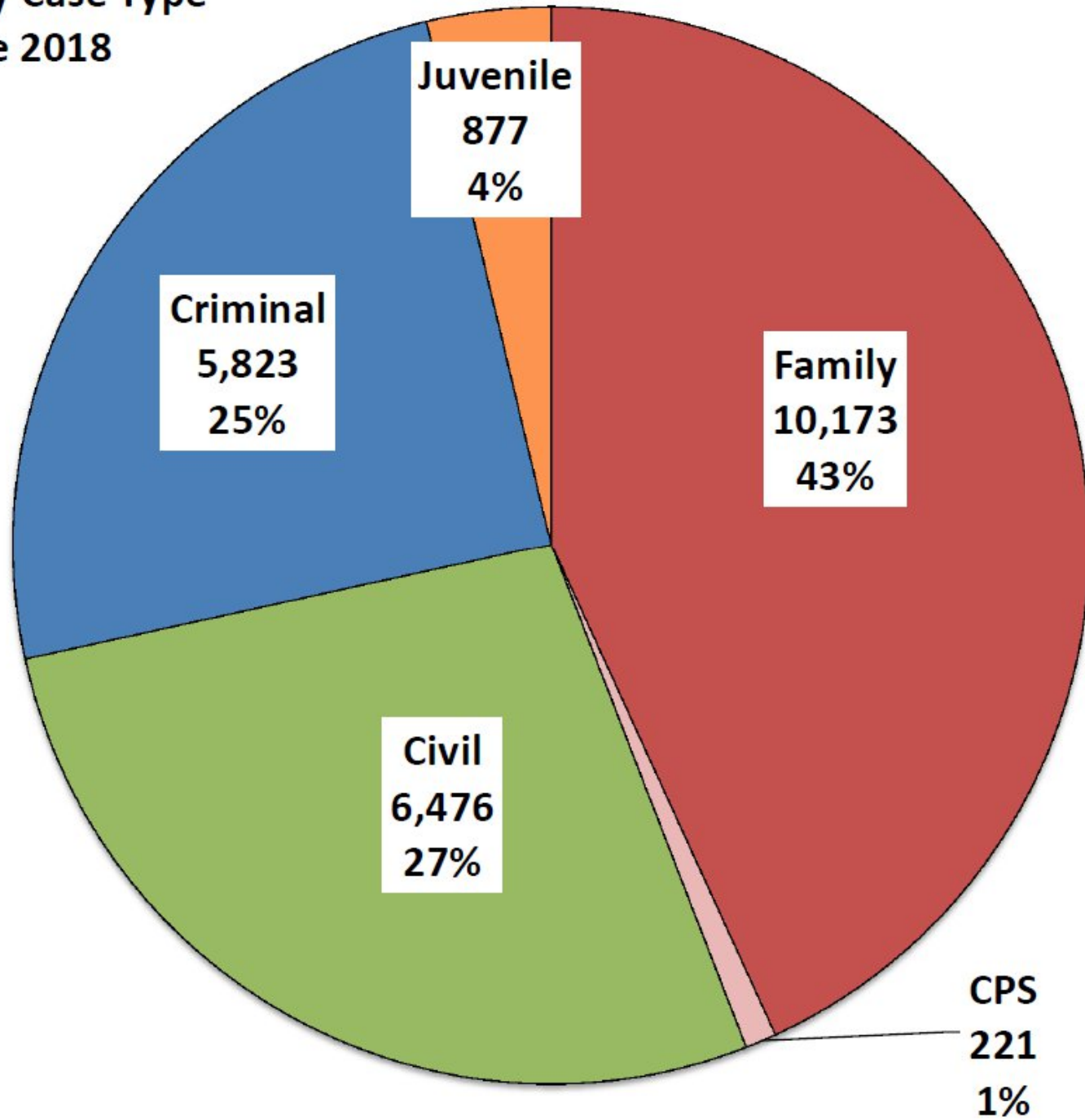

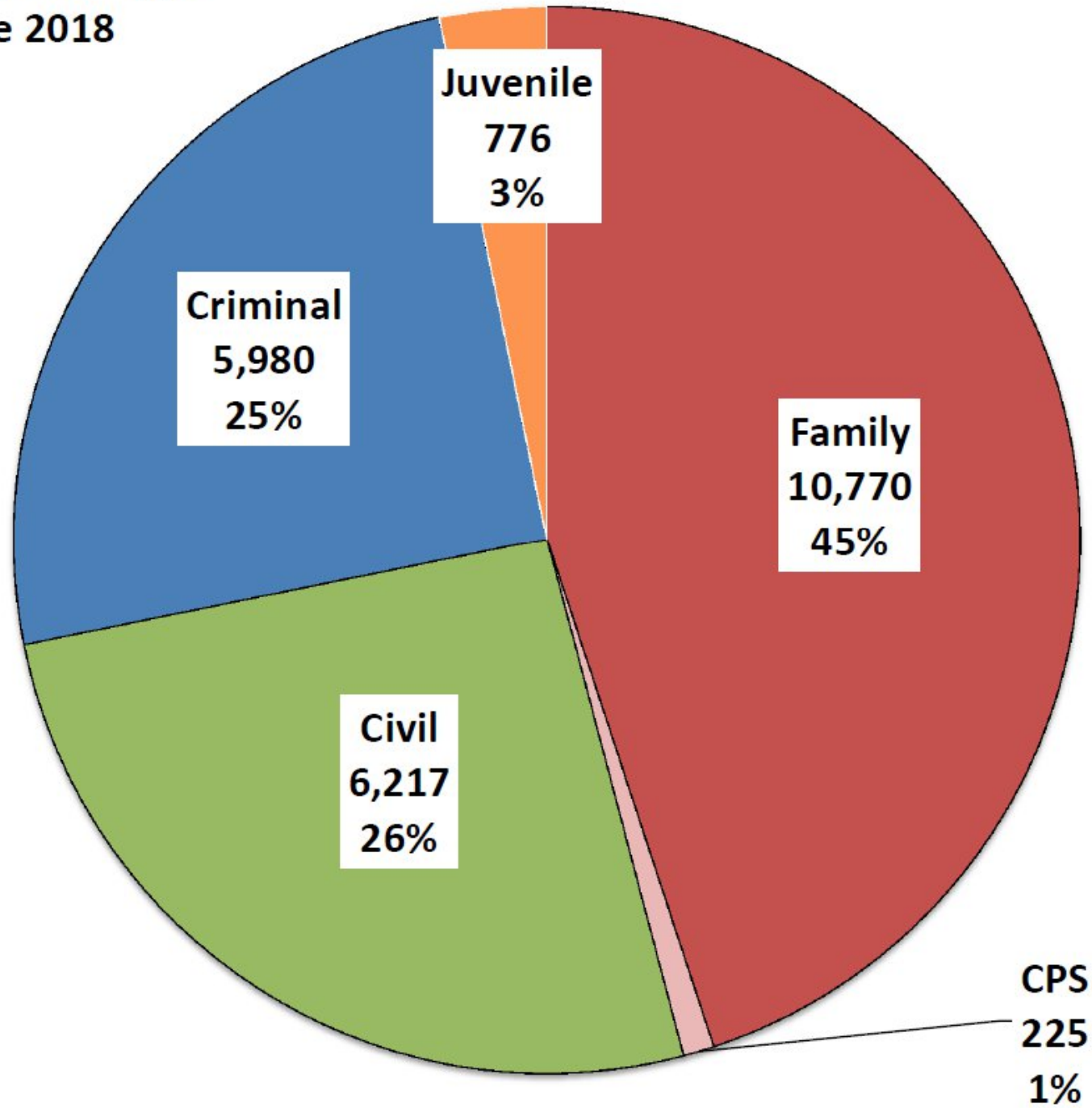




**New Cases Added by Case Type  
July 2017 - June 2018**



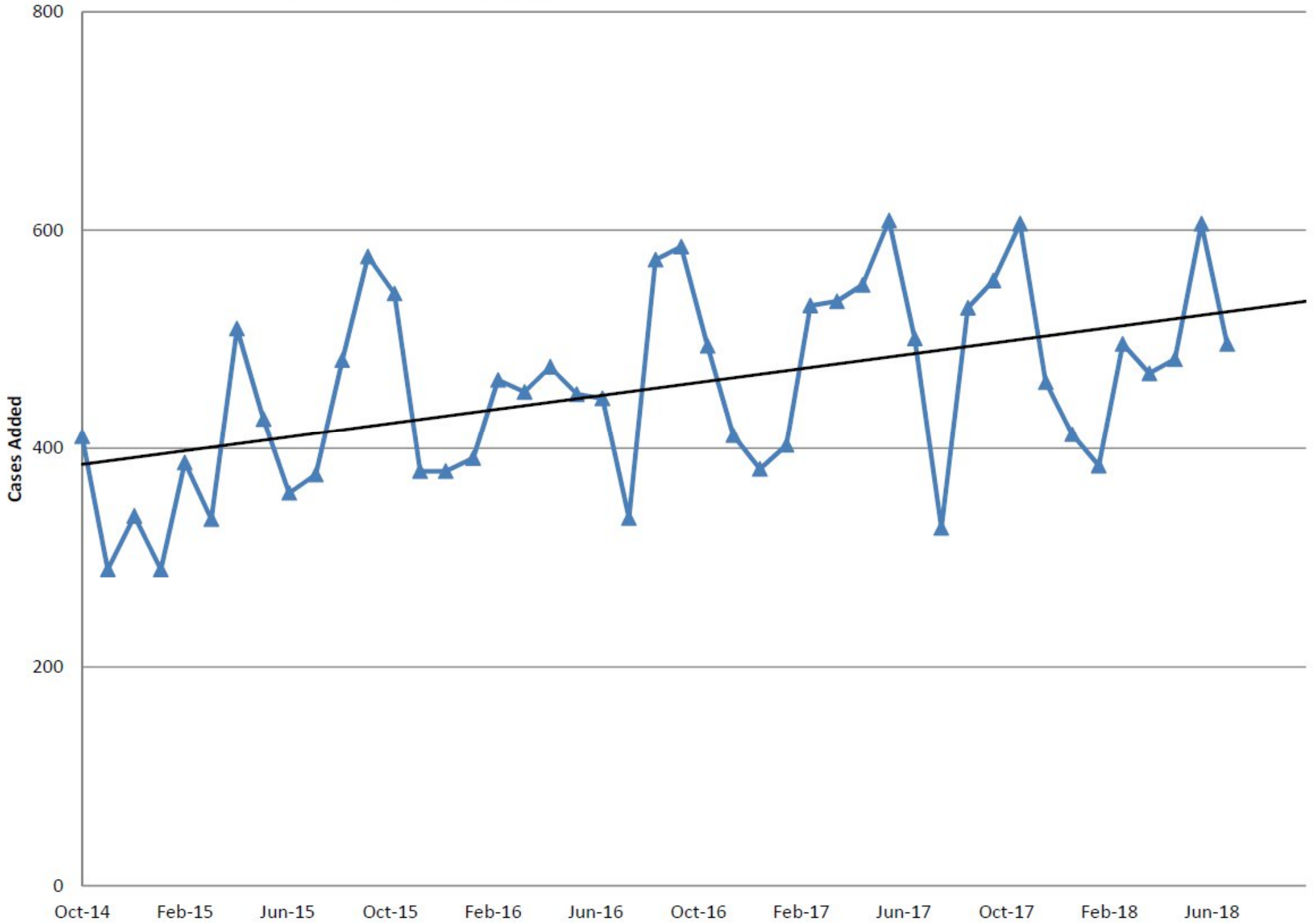
**Total Dispositions by Case Type**
