Within 2 weeks after approval by Commissioners Court, a 9-1-1 address change letter will be sent to you, your emergency service dispatcher, your post office, and the Collin Central Appraisal District. Upon receipt of the letter, you may begin using your new address for all mail correspondence. The Post Office will deliver mail addressed to your former address for approximately one year (12 months).

A blue and white metal sign and post will be provided by the Collin County Sign Shop, maintenance for which will be the responsibility of the adjoining property owners. Please contact the Sign Shop at 972-548-3715 to order your sign.
