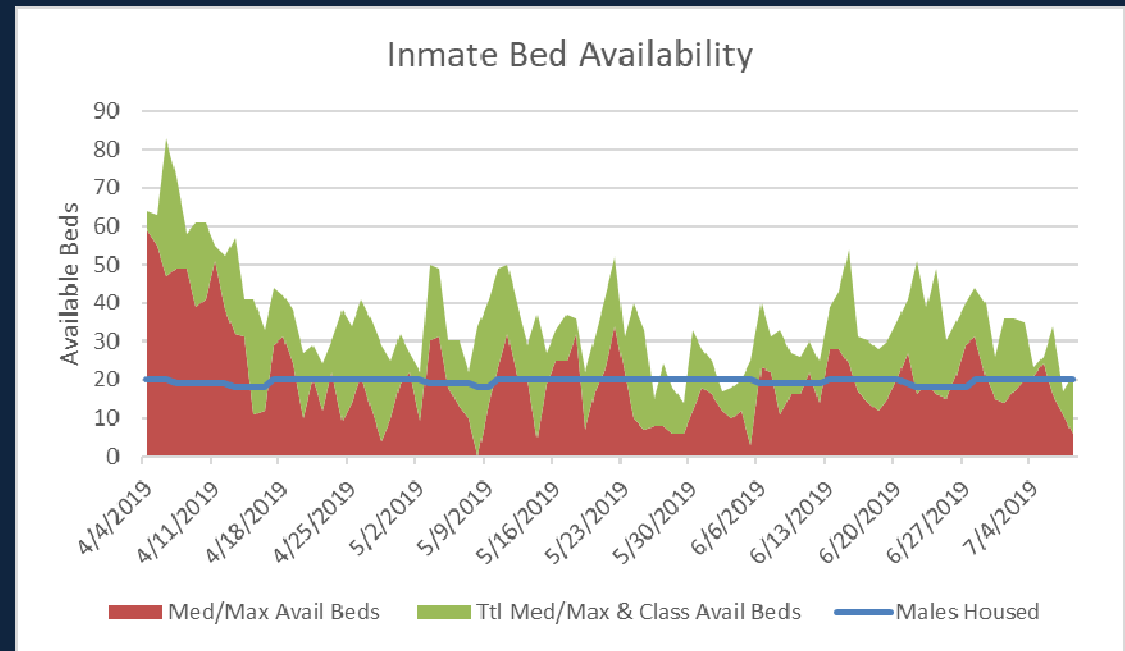




Males - Cell Availability (April 4 – July 8, 2019)

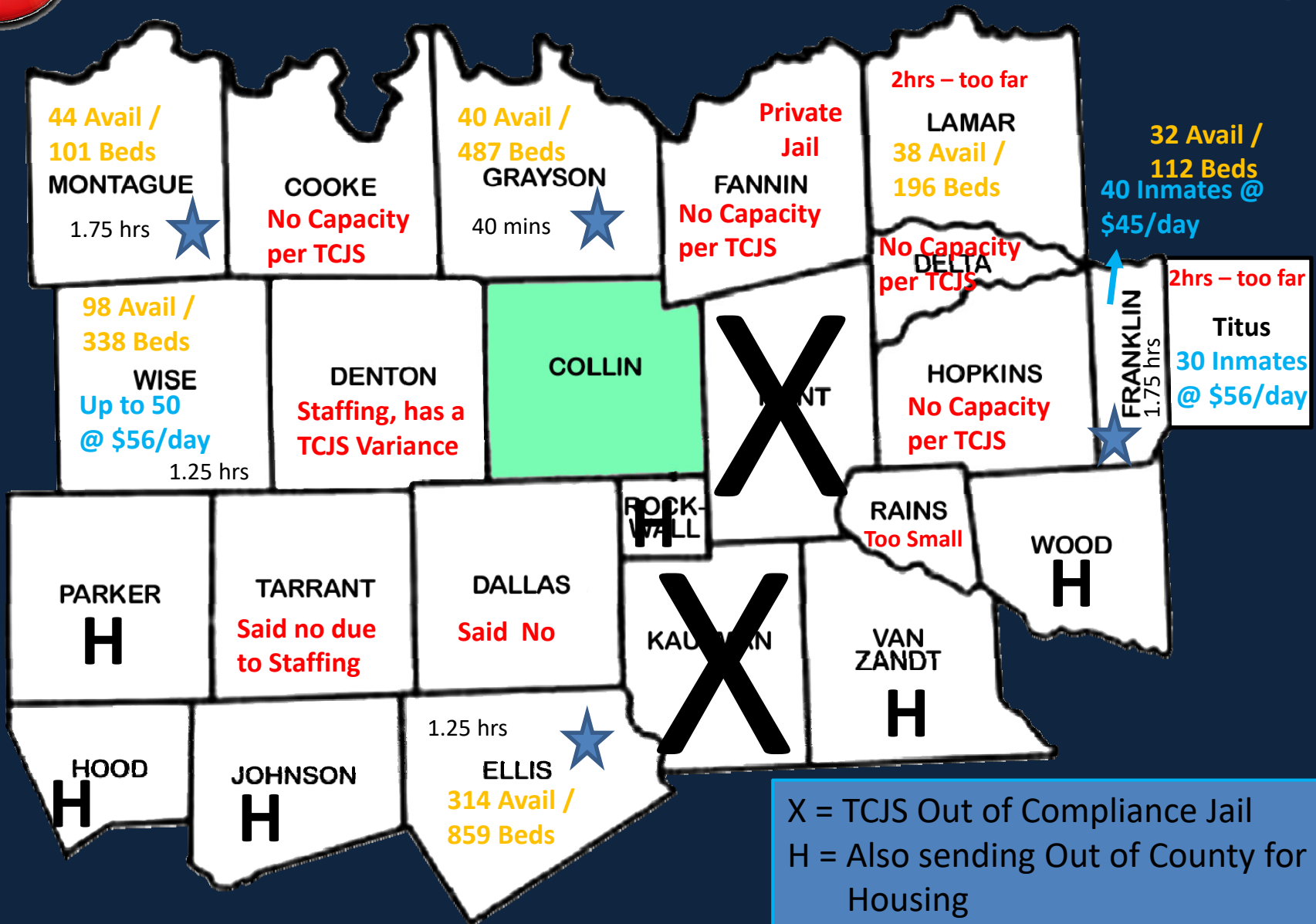
- Inmates housed out of county appear to be Medium and Medium Assault/Escape level classification
 - Thus, the availability of Med/Max cells is the primary factor to consider in evaluating sending inmates to other jails
- Also included on the chart in green is the total availability of both Med/Max cells and the Classification POD
 - This is shown for overall comparison; however, the Classification cells are used for initial housing. Generally, this is the first 72 hours of an inmate's stay while the more detailed classification process is performed.
 - Keeping the Classification POD population low is key to ensuring there is space for incoming inmates from Book-In



A factor not considered within this chart is when cells are unavailable due to facility issues, such as a A/C broken or bees

Viabile Options for ILA

- Viable options to look at further
 - Grayson, Ellis, Franklin, Montague
- Grayson
 - 40 minutes @ way via IH-75 North
 - Jail Pop per TCJS: 40 available beds out of 487
- Ellis
 - 1.25 hrs @ way
 - Rush hours would be >2hrs @ way
 - Major highway (IH-75 to IH-35 South)
 - Jail Pop per TCJS: 304 available beds out of 859
- Montague vs Franklin
 - Both 1.75 hrs @ way
 - Franklin is 380 East to IH-30
 - Montague is IH-75 to 82 West
 - Both are small jails (Jail Pop per TCJS)
 - Montague: 44 available beds out of 101
 - Franklin: 52 available beds out of 112

Wise County – For Comparison

- Comparable to Ellis
- 1.25 hours @ way
- Via 121 to IH-35 to 380 West
 - Alt: 380 West
- 98 available beds out of 338
