ELSAG Plate Hunter™ license plate reader - The ELSAG license plate reader (LPR) will be utilized by the Collin County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) to assist with identifying motor vehicles that are suspected to be or are involved in various criminal activities within the Collin County area. These criminal activities include, but not limited to kidnapping or abducting children, drug, human, and/or arms trafficking, or the recovery of stolen vehicles. Currently, only one CCSO vehicle is equipped with an LPR and that vehicle is assigned to the North Texas Criminal Interdiction Unit. The addition of this LPR will greatly enhance the capabilities of CCSO personnel to better serve the citizens of Collin County by identifying and arresting suspects affiliated with the aforementioned criminal activities.
