The City of Lucas has a long history of supporting equestrian and pedestrian activities in its jurisdiction along Lavon Lake. As a way to continue those efforts, it is the goal of the City of Lucas to support the Trinity Trail Preservation Association (TTPA) in their efforts to maintain the Trinity Trail and the Highland and Brockdale Park trailheads.

On August 15, 2019, the Lucas City Council approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Collin County and the City of Lucas to work together to coordinate and support the development and operation of the Trinity Trail as a multi-use trail at Lavon Lake.
