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
An order of the Collin County Commissioners Court granting a discretionary exemption from competitive bidding requirements.

In accordance with Texas Local Government Code section 262.024 (a)(8), the Collin County Commissioners Court hereby grants an exemption from the requirements established in section 262.023 for the purchase of items of food, as detailed in the attached documentation (Exhibit A).

In accordance with Texas Local Government Code section 262.024 (d), the Collin County Commissioners Court directs that the Purchasing Agent, or an associate thereof, shall solicit at least three bids for purchases of food items at intervals specified in the attached documentation (Exhibit A). The Purchasing Agent shall maintain and keep in the purchasing office a record of all bids solicited and vendors contacted on the form hereby approved by the Commissioners Court (Exhibit B) for a period of at least one year or until audited by the county auditor, whichever is greater.

The Collin County Commissioners Court hereby rescinds Court Order 2011-332-05-23 in its entirety.


A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, September 16, 2019.






