GENERAL DISCUSSION

Presentation, discussion and any action regarding:

5. <u>Al-47539</u> Insurance benefit changes for 2020, Human Resources.

Cynthia Jacobson, Director of Human Resources, presented the insurance benefit changes for FY2020. Currently, employees have the option for 90-day mail order prescription with the third month being covered by Collin County or 30-day retail prescription.

Ms. Jacobson asked the court to approve a \$10 dollar surcharge to cover the shipping cost for all mail order prescriptions, and have the employee cover the third month cost of prescriptions. Ms. Jacobson asked the court to approve a 90-day retail prescription plan. Human Resources goal is to have employees switch to retail prescriptions. Currently, there is a \$29 dollar flat fee charged to the County per prescription not taking into account the third month cost, which varies based off the tier the drug falls into. The County is also charged to overnight ship the prescription.

Commissioner Williams said the County has pushed the 90-day mail order to the employees for years now and it would be inappropriate to add a surcharge. Commissioner Williams suggested a delay before implementing the surcharge.

Judge Hill explained the County prides itself on offering competitive compensation packages for employees and he would like to save where possible but having the employees cover the third month of prescriptions is not where it's at, especially since they already approved it through the budget.

The Court agreed to offer 90-day retail with the County covering the third month and delaying the \$10 dollar surcharge 90 days.

Commissioner Webb asked Ms. Jacobson to clarify if the County is doing Active Enrollment this year verses other years when it was Passive Enrollment. Active Enrollment means employees must re-evaluate their previous benefit choices and elect current options for the upcoming year. Passive Enrollment allows employees to simply re-enroll in their current choices with little to no involvement. Ms. Jacobson explained Collin County employees will have an Active Enrollment this year due to a systems update.

Judge Hill expressed his concern with employees not receiving health care benefits due to new process and will work with Ms. Jacobson during active enrollment to ensure no employee is left out. (Time 1:56p.m.)
