a. AI-51440 Agreement with LaSalle Corrections, LLC for inmate housing through and including December 16, 2022, Sheriff.



EXECUTIVE SESSION


The Court did not recess into Executive Session. There being no further business of the Court, Judge Hill adjourned the meeting at 2:37 p.m.
