our percentage of change orders for a job of this magnitude is well within the scope of the job. Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to approve the item, Commissioner Hatchell seconded, and the motion passed with a 5-0 vote of the Court. (Time: 9:06:23 a.m.)

GENERAL DISCUSSION

Item No. 5 Al-26305 Consideration, discussion and any action regarding the use of time clocks in outlying areas of the county, Commissioners Court. Commissioner Cole started the discussion saying she does not think it should be optional for any group. Cynthia Jacobson stood to address the commissioners questions. Ms. Jacobson stated that those without formal time collection were: an outlying area of Road & Bridge, JP and Constable Courts in Wylie & Farmersville, the JP office in Frisco has indicated they will not go to a time clock situation, and the tax office in Frisco. The Medical Examiner's employees keep detailed records on their comings and goings which satisfy any documentation requirements. Commissioner Cole felt strongly that if most of the County employees can badge in, then everyone should be willing to clock in. Commissioner Jaynes motioned to install stand alone time clocks for these areas without securenet equipment, Commissioner Hatchell seconded, and the motion passed with a 5-0 vote of the Court. (Time: 9:14:55 a.m.)

Al-26347 Amend the Collin County policy. Commissioner Hoagland made a motion to put stand alone time clocks in for those without the securenet swiping equipment (and if someone refuses to comply, withhold their pay—discussion ensued on the legality and the exact employees involved), motion died for lack of a second. Commissioner Cole made a motion to put into payroll policy that if a department is not on the securenet equipment, then outlying areas will clock in/out manually, Commissioner Hatchell seconded, and the motion passed with a 4-1 vote of the Court. Commissioner Hoagland voted no.

Commissioner Hatchell moved to approve, Commissioner Cole seconded, and the motion passed with a 5-0 vote of the Court. (Time: 9:24:56 a.m.)

It was noted that this did not guarantee anything. Commissioner Hoagland moved to go with Judge Self's wording, Commissioner Cole seconded, and the motion passed with a 5-0 vote of the Court.
