b. <u>AI-29643</u> Consideration, discussion and any action regarding Outer Loop Segments.

Ruben Delgado, Engineering, lead this discussion and brought the Board up to date via a Power Point presentation entitled "Outer Loop Update". This Power Point was originally presented in December 2008 and was brought back for further discussion at the request of President Self. Rusty Ozmer, HNTB, came forward and stated this project would take approximately one year to begin. Mr. Delgado added once started, the project would take approximately one-and-a-half years to reach completion. Director Jaynes had questions regarding funding. Discussion followed concerning a timeline and costs for completion of the various sections and corridors of the outer loop, as well as discussion of putting out an RFQ. Bill Bilveu. Administrative Services, addressed the issue of tax rate growth and debt to ensure that the Board of Directors understood what would happen going forward. Director Jaynes wanted to see this item brought back to the February 16, 2009, Commissioners Court Workshop. Tom Burke, CH2M Hill, came forward with concerns regarding RFQs, stating it was putting CH2M Hill in an "awkward position" since they prepared a fee proposal at the request of the Commissioners

November 2008 court. Discussion followed. Frank Ybarbo, Purchasing, came forward with an explanation of the process.

President Self held item 2b at this point and moved the discussion to item 2c. (Time: 4:07 p.m.)

The Board of Directors returned to item 2b at 4:14 p.m., with Director Ward requesting the matter be tabled and brought back to a Workshop. (Time: 4:16:03 p.m.)

Discussion followed between Board members, Mr. Burke, Mr. Delgado, Ms. Homfeld and Mr. Ybarbo regarding a timeline and discount.
