Monika Arris, Budget, came forward with an explanation of the budget packets sent out to departments, stating departments were given the FY2009 Adopted Budget less any one-time expenses. Because of one-time expenditures, Ms. Arris was able to cut \$7 million out of the budget. Commissioner Ward complimented Stacey Kemp, County Clerk, for itemizing not only job descriptions for her department, but the noting the length of time needed to perform each function. Commissioner Ward wanted all departments to do the same. Commissioner Shaheen made a motion for a flat budget and no employee increases unless statutorily required. (Time: 10:22 a.m.)






