<u>Al-31108</u> Canvassing the results of the November 3, 2009, Constitutional Amendment Election, Elections

Canvassing the results of the November 3, 2009, Local Option Election for the City of Farmersville, Elections.

Sharon Rowe, Elections Administrator, came before the Court with the following accumulated totals from the November 3, 2009, election:

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 1: 15,625 votes for and 13,975 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 2: 20,722 votes for and 9,004 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 3: 20,386 votes for and 9,346 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 4: 15,855 votes for and 13,771 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 5: 19,216 votes for and 9,770 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 6: 18,840 votes for and 10,183 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 7: 23,488 votes for and 6,227 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 8: 20,894 votes for and 8,912 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 9: 21,772 votes for and 7,898 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 10: 21,283 votes for and 8,210 votes against.

Constitutional Amendment Proposition 11: 25,031 votes for and 4,779 votes against.

Ms. Rowe stated there are 408,958 registered voters in Collin County. 30,603 cards were cast in the November 3, 2009, election, representing 7.48% of the registered voters.

Ms. Rowe continued with the results of the Farmersville election:

Constitutional Amendment, Farmersville Proposition: 247 votes for and 204 votes against.

458 cards were cast, representing 0.11% of the voters in Farmersville.

Commissioner Shaheen made a motion to accept the votes as submitted by Ms. Rowe. (Time: 9:05 a.m.)
