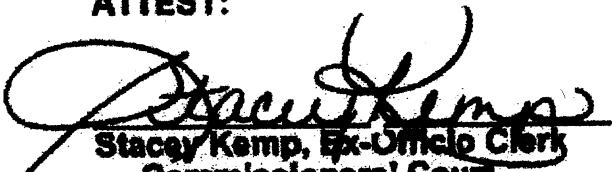

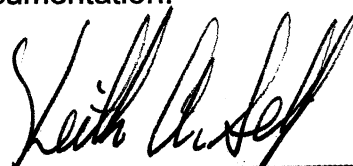
During such session the court considered a request for approval of a budget amendment in the amount of \$85,178.

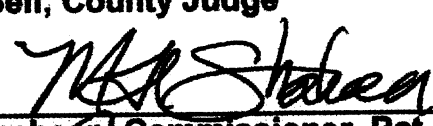
