On Monday, February 15, 2010, the Commissioners Court of Collin County, Texas, met in Regular Session in the Commissioners Courtroom, Jack Hatchell Administration Building, 4th Floor, 2300 Bloomdale Road, City of McKinney, Texas, with the following members of the Court present, and participating, to wit:

<u>ITEM NO. 1</u> Judge Self called to order the meeting of the <u>Collin County</u> Commissioners Court at 9:30 a.m.

Judge Self announced that the meeting of the <u>Collin County Toll Road</u> <u>Authority Board of Directors</u> would be postponed until the February 22, 2010, Court meeting.

Judge Self recessed the meeting of the <u>Collin County Commissioners Court</u> at 9:30 and convened the meeting of the <u>Collin County Health Care Foundation</u> <u>Board of Trustees</u>. Commissioners Court was reconvened at 9:31 a.m.

Commissioner Shaheen asked that this item be held until next week. Commissioner Jaynes stated since we have a contract, we've already agreed to the rates. (Time: 9:33 a.m.)

The Court returned to this item at 9:39 a.m. Mr. May had the information requested by Commissioner Shaheen: the rates are \$150 per hour for a partner if they are on the audit, \$90 per hour for a supervisory staff, and \$65 an hour for a staff member, as stated in the contract for this year. Commissioner Shaheen stated he wanted to make sure those rates were available to the public. (Time: 9:40 a.m.)

the Committee. The Committee voted the next day to remove the building. Commissioner Ward asked Jeff Durham, Parks and Projects Manager, to have an email sent to the Commissioners stating what happened. Commissioners Shaheen and Jaynes wanted to make sure the public was aware of this planned demolition. Judge Self asked for a future agenda item to include a briefing by Mr. Durham to the Court of all work being done at Myers Park. (Time: 9:36 a.m.)

needs to be done and he recommended the Court approve it. Commissioner Shaheen asked about the five-year payment plan and a discussion of interest charged followed. Mr. Kleinheksel said interest is 5.38%. Monika Arris, Budget, came forward to explain the bond rate and answer questions from the Court. Commissioner Jaynes made a motion to approve.
