Contractor shall provide and maintain all ambulances utilized in the performance of emergency ambulance services in accordance with all federal, state, county and city statutes, regulations, codes and ordinances. Equipment furnished shall be excellent and considered sophisticated by industry standards. On-Board equipment and supplies shall be upgraded from time to time throughout the term of the contract.

Section 6.8 Revision

Change to:

Contractor shall provide and maintain all ambulances utilized in the performance of emergency ambulance services in accordance with all federal, state, county and city statutes, regulations, codes and ordinances. Equipment furnished shall be excellent and considered sophisticated by industry standards. On-Board equipment and supplies shall be upgraded from time to time throughout the term of the contract. Only basic disposable supplies will be replaced on a "One for One, Basis." If the supplies are not replaced at the scene, (AMR's Operations Supervisor - Collin County) will need to be contacted for supply replacement or the shortage of supplies can be identified on your supply sheet, the next business day.

Currently Reads:

Contractor shall cooperate fully in furnishing emergency standby coverage, as requested by law enforcement agencies, and fire departments during events where firefighters or law enforcement personnel may be subject to injury. Such standby coverage may be furnished utilizing already on-duty ambulance units, and shall be furnished without additional compensation to Contractor, provided however, nothing in this shall prevent Contractor from seeking reimbursement for the actual transportation of such personnel.

Section 7.32.5 Revision

Change To:

Contractor shall cooperate fully in furnishing emergency standby coverage, as requested by law enforcement agencies, and fire departments during events where firefighters or law enforcement personnel may be subject to injury. Such standby coverage may be furnished utilizing already on-duty ambulance units, and shall be furnished without additional compensation to Contractor, and without seeking reimbursement from the individual, for treatment and/or transportation of such personnel while on scene, enroute to the scene, or an hour after the incident.

Disputes and/or complaints may be resolved by this Board with appeal to the governing body by the aggrieved parties.
