1. Judge Self convened the meeting of the Collin County Commissioners Court at 9:30 a.m.

Judge Self recessed the meeting of the Collin County Commissioners Court at 9:35 a.m. and convened the meeting of the Collin County Health Care Foundation.

President Self adjourned the meeting of the <u>Collin County Health Care Foundation</u> at 9:36 a.m. and convened the meeting of the <u>Collin County Toll Road Authority.</u>

President Self adjourned the meeting of the <u>Collin County Toll Road Authority</u> at 9:37 a.m. and reconvened the meeting of the <u>Collin County Commissioners Court.</u>

Jon Kleinheksel, Public Works, and David Doan, Road Maintenance, came forward. Judge Self stated the recent enforcement of the environmental program in the county was causing paint cans to pile up. The landfill will not accept old paint unless it's dry and it was too expensive to take the paint cans to a hazardous disposal company. Mr. Doan's office put together a program using old air filters, laying them out and pouring paint on them until it dried and then taking them to the landfill. Judge Self presented Mr. Doan with a gold coin for his initiative. (Time: 9:35 a.m.)

b. Collin County has earned a GOLD Leadership Circle Award from the Texas comptroller by scoring 15 of fifteen possible points on a ratings criteria for open government.

Judge Self asked Randal Rice, Auditor's office, and Susan Whitaker, IT, to come forward. They were presented with the GOLD Leadership Circle Award for County Transparency from Susan B. Combs, State Comptroller. Collin County was the first county in the nation to put their checkbook online. Ms. Whitaker and Mr. Rice were instrumental in making that happen. Judge Self read the award aloud. (Time: 9:33 a.m.)

Judge Self recessed the meeting of the Commissioners Court at 9:35 a.m. and called to order the meeting of the Collin County Health Care Foundation.

One project is for the intersection of Frankford and Hillcrest Roads and the other is for Frankford Road from Coit to Waterview, and he then provided explanation. They were asking for a budgetary adjustment for funds that were never allocated to the outlay to Frankford Road. Collin County will come out ahead as the City of Dallas has not asked for additional funds. Mr. Delgado answered follow-up questions from Court members. Judge Self made a motion to approve. (Time: 9:40 a.m.)

Commissioner Jaynes offered background on this item, updating the Court on RTR (Regional Toll Revenue) funding and the projects for which the funds were allocated. Commissioner Jaynes stated the County has accrued \$86,000,000 in interests and credits since 2007. In October 2009 TxDOT announced they were out of money, so in order to keep County projects with TxDOT moving forward, Collin County has had to use the \$86,000,000. This is an attempt to submit projects that were funded with 121 toll money to the state for pass through financing in an effort to get some of that money back. There is only \$300,000,000 left for the entire state in pass through financing. Commissioner Jaynes had questions of Ruben Delgado, Engineering, and Bill Bilyeu, Administrative Services. Commissioner Jaynes stated he wanted to meet again with Bill Hale, a TxDOT engineer. Judge Self agreed with Commissioner Jaynes, that the County may or may not get money back from the state, but he would like another meeting with Mr. Hale. Additionally, he stated he did not want to see projects delayed. Commissioner Jaynes wanted to see phase two on Highway 380 moving forward.

Commissioner Shaheen asked that this item be held until the next Court. He wanted to sit down with Mr. Delgado and look at all the work being done on Highway 380. Mr. Delgado said he would be glad to sit down with Commissioner Shaheen. Judge Self said this item would be held. (Time: 9:47 a.m.)

He stated he wants that placed on the legislative agenda because Collin County has grown 56% since 2000 and we need to make sure we have representation. Judge Self agreed, adding another issue is the deficit in the budget. Commissioner Jaynes had comments on regulations for slaughterhouses in the rural parts of the County. Judge Self asked for other comments. He wanted to make sure all of the Commissioners' comments were heard. Commissioner Shaheen wanted to protect CTA (County Toll Authority) and RTR (Regional Toll Revenue) funds; he wanted updates on the Conference of Urban Counties' County Efficiency Act. Commissioner Shaheen also wanted transportation needs to be a higher priority. Commissioner Ward suggested changing court dates and having two Commissioners present at upcoming meetings in Austin. Judge Self asked if the Commissioners wanted to make it a policy to move court dates as needed in order to have at least two Commissioners available to attend meetings. Commissioner Hoagland agreed it was a good idea. Commissioner Ward made that in the form of a motion. (Time: 9:54 a.m.)
