Judge Self stated that all but three of the signs requested are new construction and the remaining three are resident requested. Judge Self opened the hearing for public comments. Hearing none, the hearing was closed at 9:48 a.m. Commissioner Shaheen made a motion to approve. (Time: 9:48 a.m.)

7 FY2011 Budget Update:

a. Al-32255 Employee Insurance, Commissioner, Precinct 3.

Commissioner Jaynes gave a presentation regarding insurance proposals. He presented medical plan considerations which suggested adding a \$250 deductibe to the premier plan and increasing the deductible by \$250 for the standard plan for an estimated annual savings of \$425,000. He also suggested considering eliminating out of network benefits as well as eliminating any plan payments if the employee or dependent is covered under another health plan. Another suggestion was to increase specialty physician co pay for the premier plan by \$10 for an estimated annual savings of \$400,000. Commissioner Jaynes went on to present a layout of medical plan premiums with scenarios and what the cost is now and what is proposed. He stated that he doesn't want the employees to be out anymore money so he would like to see the difference in the increase of the premiums made up with the employees' pay for performance. (Time: 9:53 a.m.)

b. Al-32256 Retirement Insurance, Commissioner, Precinct 3.

Commissioner Jaynes went on to present considerations for retiree medical plans. He stated that in the beginning the retiree medical was not intended to be used as a retiree's initial medical insurance. The intention was for retirees over the age of 65 with 20 years of service to use Medicare and use the retiree plan to fill in the gaps. With retirees not doing this, the unfunded liabilities budget is at approximately \$40 to \$80 million. Commissioner Jaynes suggested getting the retirees who are over 65 with 20 years of service to use Medicare and have the County buy a Medigap plan. The numbers have not been done yet but he proposed that doing this would bring down the unfunded liabilities significantly. Commissioner Shaheen asked when the Court could receive the numbers to show the amount of savings. Cynthia Jacobson, Human Resources, came forward to say that Medigap has been discussed as a potential alternative but they have to submit an RFP to receive the numbers. Judge Self stated that they will be presenting numbers on this matter on August 16th. (Time: 9:56 a.m.)

Judge Self called Monika Arris, Budget, to approach. Judge Self asked what, in terms of dollars, would the shortfall of the budget this year be from last year. Ms. Arris stated that the certified numbers were received that past Friday and the numbers are down 1.5%. She stated that if the tax rate remains the same as last year then that is a loss of \$2.7 million in tax revenues. Judge Self made a motion to take items 8a through 8e off of this agenda and allow the personnel managers to manage their hiring. (Time: 9:58 a.m.)

Carrie Brazeal, Texas Agrilife Extension Service, came forward to discuss a part time position that consisted of training teachers to use the research space curriculum in the classroom. The curriculum is in the areas of science and technology and puts students who are lacking in a standard curriculum in a more hands on environment. During this fiscal year, 66 schools and 8 school districts were serviced. This includes 950 teachers and approximately over 14,000 students, with 2700 volunteer hours that were recorded. Ms. Brazeal stated that when she met with the Court earlier in June they directed her to go to the school districts that were serviced and see if they would be willing to help fund this position. Ms. Brazeal sent a letter to the school districts signed by Judge Self. Frisco ISD, Wylie ISD, McKinney ISD and Lovejoy ISD replied stating that their fiscal years ended on July 1st and their budgets were set without any discretionary funds. She stated that if the position is frozen then approximately 80% of the schools will be unable to participate in the program. Judge Self questioned if Agrilife had layoffs this year to which Ms. Brazeal stated that they did but they had no affect on Collin County. Commissioner Jaynes made the motion to approve. (Time: 10:03 a.m.)

Commissioner Jaynes stated that item number 8 regarding redistricting was a given but Judge Self stated that they might need to give their input on this because they will not carry the bill for the county. Commissioner Ward stated that on item 3 regarding a two-tiered retirement system within TCDRS, Commissioner Shaheen could possibly speak to other counties to see if they are interested in their state representative carrying this item because there is wide support. Commissioner Shaheen stated he has a Conference of Urban Counties meeting this week and will discuss this as well as gas tax diversions. Judge self suggested Commissioner Shaheen take the list to the meeting to see which state representative might be willing to carry any of the items. Commissioner Jaynes made a motion to approve.
