President Self asked Jeff May, County Auditor, to enlighten the Board as to the meaning of a section of the report that stated "The minimum required fund balance for the Health Care Foundation has dropped below the threshold to \$14,238,375" per a 1983 agreement. Mr. May replied the date was when the Health Care Foundation Trust was formed and the original balance was what the old hospital sold for. Once the balance drops below the original amount, it is debatable how the money can be used. Mr. May said it is his understanding that pursuant to the by-laws the funds can only be used for indigent health care. Any other spending such as grants would have to be debated by the Board. They also need to take a closer look at the by-laws to verify the money can be used. President Self directed Bill Bilyeu, County Administrator, to get a legal opinion regarding the 1983 agreement.
