REF: Request to Upgrade Radio Interoperability Equipment for Mobile Command Post

Homeland Security is requesting approval from Commissioners Court to upgrade the existing ACU-1000 radio interoperability gateway in the Mobile Incident Command Post to an ACU-5000 in a technology trade-in program offered by Raytheon. The technology trade-in program will allow Collin County to save \$11,288 and replace technology that is now 5+ years old.

The equipment cost for this upgrade is \$17,532.00. 2009 State Homeland Security Grant Funding (SHSGP) grant funding will be used to pay for \$6,963.31 and \$10,568.69 in remaining funds from hurricane response reimbursement from FEMA will be used to pay for the remainder.

No money from Collin County will be used for this project.
