While Ms. Milligan tried to be reassuring, the end result is that this is an attempt by the state to decrease their portion of the cost of Medicaid by increasing local government's portion. It is Commissioner Williams' personal opinion that eventually, there will be pressure for counties to contribute additional tax dollars. There is concern about Collin County being involved with Parkland Hospital in a region; it is critical for the county to not be included. It is also critical that the county meet with the representative from the Texas Association of Counties (TAC) to ensure they understand Collin County's concerns. A brief discussion followed.
