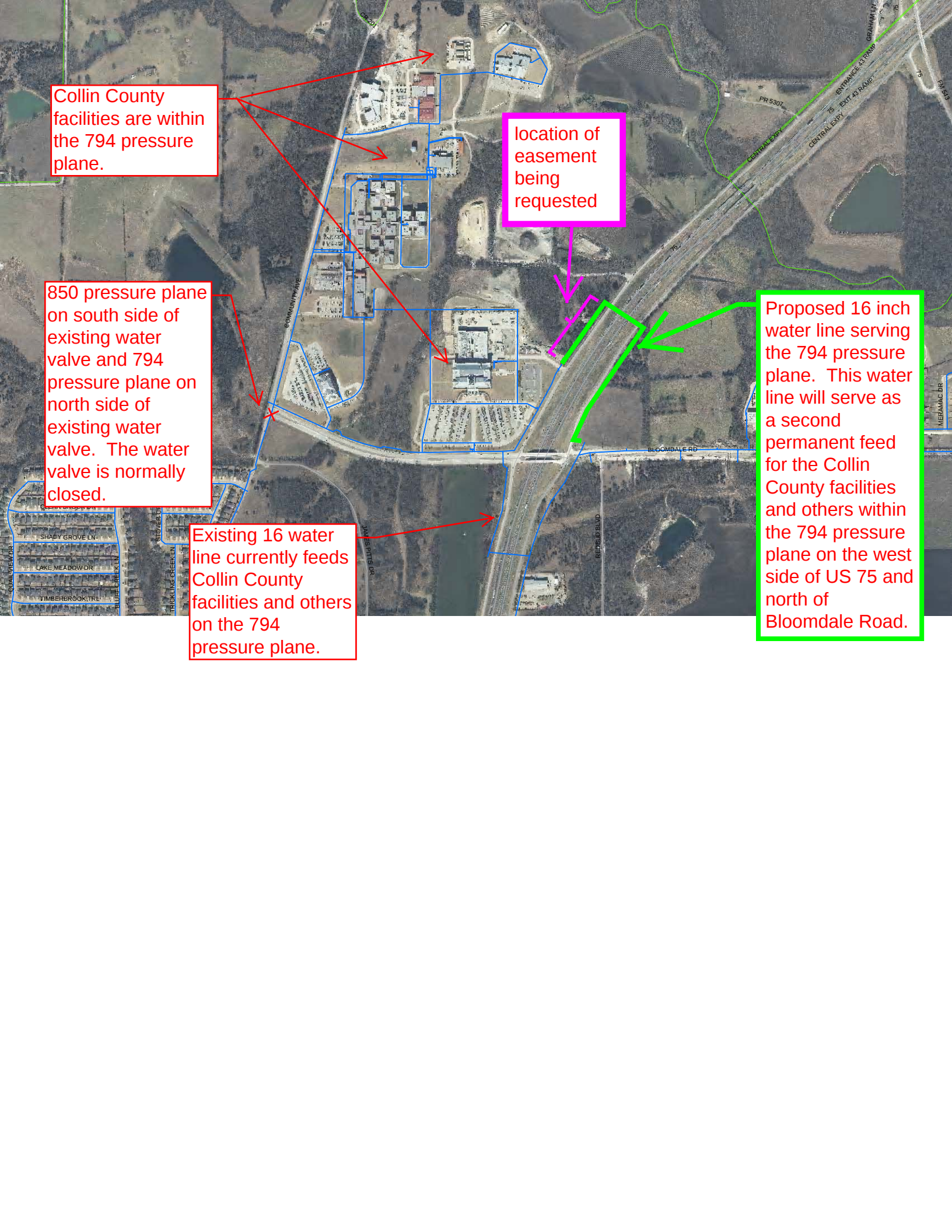




Collin County facilities are within the 794 pressure plane.
