Commissioner Webb stated that on the long-term debt schedule it shows that the interest rates go from 4.6 to 6.3 in regards to the Build America Bond. He asked for some explanation on exactly what was going on with this grant and why there was a reduction in the county match when in the presentation it stated the county match would be 10%. This implied the match should have been around \$7,000. Rick Allen, Chief Deputy in the Sheriff's Office, approached the podium and stated that when he addressed the Court in the spring, he was not sure what the numbers were going to be or what the County's responsibility would be. Mr. Allen stated that two weeks ago the grant was approved. When the numbers came up, the numbers were \$2,000 for this approved year. It will remain \$2,000 for the three year commitment. Judy Florence, Parks Manager, stated there have been several incidents where cancellations have occurred 30 days prior to the scheduled event. When this happens, the park does not have a chance to book another event on such a short notice. This leads to an issue of lost revenues. Commissioner Shaheen stated he felt that the loss of a deposit when cancelling 60-90 days prior to the event seemed a little excessive. He wanted to know if other organizations used 60-90 days as their standard. Ms. Florence stated that this is based on recommendations because of experiences with cancellations that have occurred recently.

Commissioner Webb stated that he is fine with this amendment because of the loss of revenue. He further stated a correction should be made to state that any cancellations made less than 60 days from the scheduled event would result in a lost deposit, plus a charge for the full amount of the rental fee. Judge Self asked if charging the full rental amount plus the loss of the deposit would hurt future bookings. Ms. Florence said she does not foresee this being an issue, but she could not be sure. Ms. Florence said this amendment has been made to encourage individuals to cancel in advance and so another event can be booked for that date. Commissioner Shaheen asked Ms. Florence to see what other entities do in terms of cancellations. (Time: 1:46 p.m.)
