Re: "FYI" Lake Texoma Pipeline

Freese and Nichols is the engineering consulting firm selected to manage the construction of the Lake Texoma Pipeline. Traversing 48 miles, the 96" pipeline will route Lake Texoma water around Lake Lavon directly into the NTMWD facility in Wylie upon completion in November 2013. Construction of the Collin County segment is expected to commence next month.

Freese and Nichols along with their general contractor, Garney, met with Public Works on September 9th to discuss issues and timetables. Due to the project, certain county roads will experience a marked increase in traffic, specifically haul trucks. Therefore, Public Works captured full motion video of all affected roads which will be utilized as a reference point to assess cumulative damage once the project concludes.

The contractor has complied with all County permitting requirements and procedures. In addition, the contractor has agreed to pay restitution for repairs to any county roads impacted by construction throughout this process.

Public Works will continue monitoring the project's progress and coordinate closely with the contractors to ensure safety and minimize inconvenience for county citizens.
