Relating to the composition of the governing boards of Regional Planning Commissions under section 391.006 of the Texas Local Government Code.

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

__B ____ amends section 391.006 of the Local Code so as to add a new subsection (d) allowing a County with a population of more than 650,000 but less than 850,000 according to the most recent federal decennial census to appoint a member to the governing body of a commission for that region. It is believed that Counties of this size should have representation on the governing boards of their respective regional planning commissions.

ANALYSIS

Section 1: Amends Section 391.006 of the Texas Local Government Code

This Bill amends Section 391.006 of the Texas Local Government Code to add subsection “d” which will allow a County with a population of more than 650,000 but less than 850,000 according to the most recent federal decennial census to appoint a member to the governing body of a commission for that region.

Section 2: Effective Date of the Act

This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
