The addressing recommendations listed below will be made to the Collin County Commissioners Court by the 9-1-1 Rural Addressing office at the public session on April 15, 2013, which you are welcome to attend. **Please don't make any changes yet** – in the week after approval by the commissioners court, a final 9-1-1 address correction approval letter will be sent to you, your emergency service dispatcher, your post office, and the Collin Central Appraisal District.

The County will then install one (1) blue and white metal road sign with post, contact information will be included in the 9-1-1 address correction approval letter.

Property deeds are not affected by a change in address - even though the deed may reference a physical address, the legal description is the permanent property identifier. This office will provide an address verification letter at no charge, if ever needed in the future.
