- The fulfillment of these requests help support criminal investigations and other matters related to emergency management, critical infrastructure, fire, and public health from all levels of government affecting our region and state

Terrorist Screening Center



- The Terrorist Screening Center (TSC) was created in 2003 to help support the front line efforts against terrorism
- By supporting the ability of front-line screening agencies to positively identify known or suspected terrorists, the consolidated Terrorist Watchlist is one of the most effective counterterrorism tools for the U.S. government

Intelligence Products



- In order to support the mission of the NCTFC a collaborative effort has been made to create and disseminate timely and relevant intelligence products
- Those products help the NCTFC accomplish its all-crimes/all-hazards approach to prevention, response and mitigation of incidents
