GENERAL DISCUSSION

5. Al-37034 Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) Award, Public Works.

Jon Kleinheksel, Public Works, came forward to explain Collin County has targeted three areas for tire clean up. He introduced Joe LaBarbera, who represents Texas Association of RC&D (Resource Conservation and Development) which is a third party for TCEQ (Texas Commission on Environmental Quality). When counties are assessed fines, the third party, which is non profit, administers the grant funds. Under the SEP (Supplemental Environmental Project) these funds can only be used for tire clean up. The three locations targeted are in McKinney, Princeton and Leonard and contain approximately 700 tires. Under TCEQ rules the funds must be used to recycle the tires. Mr. LaBarbera solicits companies, who are certified by TCEQ, to pick up and recycle the tires.

The grant is \$296,000 and is to be used for any clean up along the Trinity Aquifers and Trinity Watershed, not just Collin County. These funds must be used by March of next year. Mr. LaBarbera will present the best bids for the work to the County Commissioners for approval. After a brief discussion, it was determined the best way for Mr. LaBarbera to coordinate with the Commissioners would be through Jon Kleinheksel. (Time: 1:47 p.m.)
