Dear Collin County Resident / Postmaster:

Collin County is participating in the 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System by assigning rural addresses to a standard physical addressing system, to make it easier for the sheriff's office, fire department, and/or ambulance services to find you in an emergency.

According to our records, your residence on the Greer Johnson survey Abstract 478, Tract 24 was originally addressed as 10462 N State Highway 78 on June 19, 1999.

This address is not consistent with Collin County 9-1-1 addressing guidelines: the driveway entrance has been moved approximately 850 feet from the original location.

To correct the 9-1-1 database, the Rural Addressing Office will request that an address update be placed on the Collin County Commissioners' Court agenda for November 4, 2013 (the scheduled court date is subject to change – for the latest agenda notice, go to

www.co.collin.tx.us/commissioners_court/commcourt_agenda.jsp).

Upon approval of changes by the Commissioners Court, a letter will be sent to you confirming the following correction. **Do NOT** begin making any changes now.

Your corrected 9-1-1 address will be: **10616 N STATE HIGHWAY 78**
BLUE RIDGE, TX 75424

The telephone company, the Collin Central Appraisal District, your emergency service dispatcher, and your post office will also be notified of this change in the 9-1-1 database after approval. This address correction will be effective immediately after the Commissioners Court approval, but mail to the old address will continue to be delivered for one year.

The two Collin County Department of Public Safety (DPS) offices in McKinney and Plano will update the address on drivers licenses at no charge, when shown this 9-1-1 address correction letter.

Property deeds are not affected by a change in address - even though the deed may reference a physical address, the legal description is the permanent property identifier.
