**Subject: Resolution, Periodic, Contract, Non-Salaried Associate Judge for Probate Court**

During such session the court considered adoption of a Resolution authorizing the Judge of the Collin County Probate Court to appoint an associate judge on a periodic, non-salaried, contract basis with no additional funding for such associate judge being necessary.

**WHEREAS**, this Court has heretofore budgeted funds for visiting judges for the Collin County Probate Court, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 54A.203 of the Texas Government Code grants the Commissioners Court authority to authorize the Judge of the Collin County Probate Court to appoint an associate judge; and

**WHEREAS**, such associate judge can be a periodic, contract, non-salaried position, and


**WHEREAS**, the performance of certain tasks by a periodic, contract, associate judge will result in reduced expenditures for Collin County.


**Now, therefore, be it ordered by the Collin County Commissioners court as follows:**

1. The foregoing recitals, having been found to be true and correct, are incorporated herein as findings of fact.
2. The Commissioners Court authorizes the creation of an associate judge position for the Collin County Probate Court on a periodic, contract, non-salaried basis. Compensation for this position shall be paid from funds allocated in Account # 001-2001-442-6416 (Visiting Judge Fund).




Mark Reid, Commissioner, Pct. 1
