

Notice is hereby given of a public hearing to be held on behalf of Hackberry Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the "Issuer") on April 28, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of Bracewell & Giuliani LLP, 1445 Ross Ave., Suite 3800, Dallas, Texas 75202 with respect to the captioned bonds to be issued by the Issuer in one or more series (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$10,000,000. The proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to Coram Deo Academy (the "School"), for the purposes of: (i) paying the costs of issuance of the Bonds, (ii) funding debt service reserve funds for the Bonds, (iii) financing and/or refinancing all or a portion of the costs of the acquisition, construction, extension, repair, renovation, improvement and equipping of educational and related facilities, including the cost of acquiring land in connection therewith, such facilities being or to be located (A) on the campus of the School located at 4900 Wichita Trail, Flower Mound, Texas 75022 (the "Flower Mound Campus") and (B) on the approximately three-acre tract of land located on the southwest corner of Independence Parkway and Ridgeview Drive, Plano, Texas 75025 (the "Plano Campus"), and (iv) paying the cost of redeeming the "Coram Deo Academy, Inc., Flower Mound, Texas First Mortgage Bonds, 2009 Series" (the "Series 2009 Bonds"), currently outstanding in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,238,000 ((ii) through (iv), collectively, the "Project").

The proceeds of the Series 2009 Bonds were used to pay off a bank loan and to pay for the various renovation and expansion costs at the Flower Mound Campus, including the addition of classrooms and site improvements thereto.

The School will be the initial owner and operator of the Project. The public hearing will be conducted by Jonathan C. Leatherberry or his designee (the "Hearing Officer"). All interested persons are invited to attend such public hearing to express their views with respect to the Project and the Bonds. 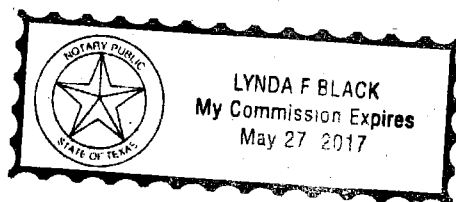

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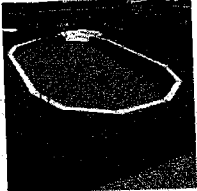
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
