

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRISCO, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF ROCKHILL ROAD TO ROCKHILL PARKWAY, BETWEEN PRESTON ROAD AND COIT ROAD AND BETWEEN DOE CREEK ROAD AND FM 423; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, SAVINGS & REPEALING CLAUSES.**

WHEREAS, the City of Frisco, Texas (“Frisco”) has initiated a request to rename Rockhill Road to Rockhill Parkway between Preston Road and Coit Road and between Doe Creek Road and FM 423, (see **Exhibit “A”**), in Frisco, Collin County, and Denton County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Frisco has investigated into and determined that it will be advantageous and beneficial to Frisco and its inhabitants to rename Rockhill Road to Rockhill Parkway, between Preston Road and Coit Road and between Doe Creek Road and FM 423, as set forth below.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRISCO, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1: Findings Incorporated. The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Renaming Rockhill Road. Rockhill Road is hereby renamed to Rockhill Parkway, between Preston Road and Coit Road and between Doe Creek Road and FM 423. All ordinances and plats of Frisco referring to Rockhill Road, between Preston Road and Coit Road and between Doe Creek Road and FM 423, are amended to Rockhill Parkway and said ordinances and plats shall otherwise remain in full force and effect. The general location of the street name change is depicted on **Exhibit “A”**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 3: Severability. Should any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is expressly provided that any and all remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Frisco hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance, and each

section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

**SECTION 4: Savings/Repealing Clause.** All provisions of any ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict; but such repeal shall not abate any pending prosecution for violation of the repealed ordinance, nor shall the repeal prevent a prosecution from being commenced for any violation if occurring prior to the repeal of the ordinance. Any remaining portions of said ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption.



**from Preston Road to Coit Road**


