

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC HEARING

3. At the time for the commencement of the hearing, I publicly requested comments, either orally or in writing, on the facilities to be financed or refinanced with proceeds of the Bonds and on the issuance of the Bonds.

4. At the hearing, no persons presented comments, orally or in writing.

5. I imposed no time limitations on any public comments.
