Re: EMC Equipment Donation – No Cost Associated

The Collin County Information Technology department requests approval for the acceptance of donated equipment from EMC. EMC is one of the equipment manufacturers on the current IT standards list approved by Commissioners Court. By accepting this donation from EMC, the county will be positioned to respond to county storage needs while we develop long term solutions for these upcoming projects.

This solution utilizes a mix of solid state drives (SSD) and traditional hard disk drives (HDD) to provide a mixture of high performance and high capacity storage. The value of this equipment, including implementation cost, is \$115,915.40. The equipment has a seven-year life expectancy and includes maintenance support through June 30, 2019.

Following this date, the county may opt to purchase annual maintenance renewals at an estimated cost of \$20,645. Should the county need to expand the solution, we may do so in 20TB increments at an approximate cost of \$29,600.
