Monika Arris, Budget, came forward with a PowerPoint presentation on the FY2017 Proposed Budget. The budget is \$189.8 million which includes cash funding the second phase of the Sheriff's Office radio system at \$7.5 million. This is a 3.8% increase from the FY2016 adopted budget. The Road & Bridge Fund budget is decreasing by \$522,922 which is a decrease of 2.2%. The proposed Operating budget consisting of the General Fund, Road & Bridge Fund and Permanent Improvement Fund is \$215.3 million. This is an increase of 3% over the prior year and does include the \$7.5 million radio system for the Sheriff's Office.

The population in Collin County has increased by 300,719 since FY2007. During that same time period, the expenditures per capita have decreased 17.7% and the revenues per capita have decreased by 16.5%. The proposed Combined Funds budget for FY2017 is \$322.7 million. Without the \$7.5 million for the radio system, the proposed Combined Funds budget would be \$315.2 million which is a 4% increase from FY2016. The FY2017 proposed total revenue estimate is \$320.4 million vs. the \$322.7 million in expenditures.

Two items were added to the add/delete list and will need to be voted on. These include a change in a Human Resources position and moving Indigent Defense from the County Clerk to Alysse Ferguson's group. (Time: 1:44 p.m.)

Judge Self opened the Public Hearing on the proposed FY2017 Budget at 1:45 p.m. and asked for comments. Hearing no comments, Judge Self closed the public hearing at 1:45 p.m.

Judge Self asked Stacey Kemp, County Clerk, what positions from Indigent Defense would be moving to Alysse Ferguson. Ms. Kemp said the positions would be the Indigent Defense Coordinator, the existing Legal Clerk I and the additional position that was requested during budget. (Time: 1:45 p.m.)
