Commissioner Webb called to order the meeting of the <u>Collin County Commissioners' Court</u> at 1:30 p.m. and recessed the meeting at 1:47 p.m. The meeting was reconvened and immediately recessed into Executive Session at 1:48 p.m. The meeting was reconvened at 1:58 p.m. and adjourned at 1:59 p.m.

Trustee Webb called to order the meeting of the <u>Collin County Health Care</u> <u>Foundation</u> at 1:47 p.m. and adjourned the meeting at 1:47 p.m.

Director Webb called to order the meeting of the <u>Collin County Toll Road Authority</u> at 1:47 p.m. and adjourned the meeting at 1:48 p.m.

Commissioner Fletcher pulled the list of disbursements for attorney fees. She said the Court is now aware of the regular practice of judges using their discretion to pay above plan standards. The Commissioner is opposed to this practice as it is disingenuous. The County has a plan in place for a reason. She urged the Court to consider what can be done to get clarification about the broad authority the judges have. While opposed to paying above the plan she realizes the attorneys have done what was asked of them but would like the disbursements pushed to the next agenda to discuss this issue further with legal counsel. Commissioner Williams recommended selecting the most out of line disbursement to challenge. Commissioner Webb agreed and said that is why he pulled the disbursement to Matthew Goeller for \$5,656.25 which is six times the flat state standard rate. This disbursement is for a felony case and falls under the District Court policy. The Court could move forward on appeal on the basis of whether or not the exception for special circumstances applies. He said is not in support of not paying the attorneys who did work pursuant to the County Court at Law policy which are included in the list with District Court disbursements.
