Dear Judge Self,

The rules for this program (43TAC § 29.3) were established based on Transportation Code §201.706, Local Government Assistance in 1997. The rule requires the Department to give materials to the counties to assist in repairing and maintaining county roads damaged by the impact of the 2060 Weight Tolerance Permits. This legislation requires that at least \$6,000,000 worth of materials be given each year to counties in the state. The allocation to all of the state's 254 counties should be primarily satisfied with surplus materials.

Rider 43 to the department's appropriations for fiscal years 1998-1999 requires the department to assist cities and counties with the maintenance of city streets and county roads by providing engineering/maintenance expertise on roadway maintenance and when surplus materials are available, the department shall make available the surplus materials to any local government needing such materials.

The fiscal year 2017 allocation for Collin County is \$31,216.

If we have not received your response within forty five days, the amount set aside for your county may be made available to other counties within the Dallas District.
