On **May 8, 2017**, the Commissioners Court of Collin County, Texas, met in **regular session** with the following members present and participating, to wit:

During such session the court considered a request for support of Mental Health Priorities from the 85th Legislative Session.

Thereupon, a motion was made seconded and carried with a majority vote of the court to ensure mental health priorities are funded in the final version of the appropriations bill including:

- \$62.6m for outpatient mental health treatment to eliminate outpatient wait lists for adults and children and address disparities in access to services;
- \$50m for the creation of matching grant programs to county-based community collaboratives to reduce recidivism and decrease wait times for forensic commitments;
 and
- Inpatient psychiatric care:
 - \$24m to maintain FY 2017 service capacity for community beds;
 - \$59.6m for an additional 100 community beds;
 - \$188.6m to address current State Hospital and State Supported Living Centers maintenance and safety issues; and

\$50m to increase maximum security inpatient psychiatric bed capacity.
