Please see the attached request from the Texas Department of Transportation to provide 10% local right-of-way participation funding for the Parker Road (FM 2514) improvements from North of Drain Drive to Brown Street.

The City of Wylie is requesting assistance from the County in funding the \$228,364.90 cost associated with right-of-way acquisition required from TxDOT for this project. Not having performed a TxDOT project in the last few years, the City was unaware of the 10% local required match involved and, therefore has not previously set funds aside for this purpose.
