During such session the court considered adoption of the following resolution supporting the Texas Property Tax Reform and Relief Act of 2017.

Whereas, SB 2, the Texas Property Tax Reform and Relief Act of 2017, seeks to instill transparency in the local government budgeting process; and,

Whereas, SB 2 does not cap local government revenues or budgets; and,

Whereas, SB 2 requires, in addition to the standard budgeting process, a local election be held if local budgets grow by more than four percent; and,

Whereas, SB 2 requires the local election to be held on a uniform election date; and,

Whereas, Collin County recognizes the burden of unfunded mandates placed on local governments, we hereby request an amendment that would require any unfunded mandates to be exempt from the formula used to determine budget growth; and,

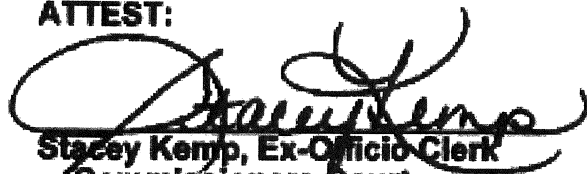
Whereas, Collin County will continue to carefully guard taxpayer dollars through our normal budgeting process.

Now, Therefore, the members of the Collin County Commissioners Court give their support for SB 2.

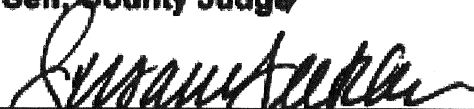
