RE: Boundary Changes to Voting Precincts

Section 42.006 of the Texas Election Code prohibits voting precincts from containing more than 5,000 registered voters. Rapid population growth in Collin County has caused twelve voting precincts to exceed the maximum number of registered voters allowed in a voting precinct. The Elections Department requests Commissioner's Court consideration and approval of the following precinct boundary changes:

If approved, request Commissioner's Court approval to publish notice of the precinct boundary changes in a newspaper in the county once a week for three consecutive weeks (per Section 42.035 Texas Election Code). The voting precinct changes become effective January 1, 2018.
