During such session the court considered adoption of the following resolution supporting the Texas Department of Agriculture, Texans Feeding Texans: Home Delivered Meal Grant Program.

A Resolution of the County of Collin, Texas certifying that the County has made a grant to Meals on Wheels Collin County, (Organization) an organization that provides home-delivered meals to homebound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability and certifying that the County has approved the organization's accounting system or fiscal agent.

WHEREAS, the Organization desires to apply for grant funds from the Texas Department of Agriculture to supplement and extend existing services to homebound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability, pursuant to the Home-Delivered Meal Grant Program (Program); and

WHEREAS, the Program rules require the County in which an Organization is providing home-delivered meal services to make a grant to the Organization, in order for the Organization to be eligible to receive Program grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Program rules require the County to approve the Organization's accounting system or fiscal agent, in order for the Organization to be eligible to receive Program grant funds.

WHEREAS, the County recognizes Marzella Tyson, Chief Executive Officer/ Executive Director (Authorized Official) as an official of the Organization.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The County hereby certifies that it has made a grant to the Organization in the amount of \$24,478.25 to be used between the 1st of February, 2018 and the 31st of January, 2019.

SECTION 2: The County hereby certifies that the Organization provides home-delivered meals to homebound persons in the County who are elderly and/or have a disability.

SECTION 3: The County hereby certifies that it has approved the Organization's accounting system or fiscal agent which meets financial management system requirements as set forth in Uniform Grant Management Standards.
