Dear Mark Sanderson:

For the past several months, the Texas Department of Public Safety has been implementing upgrades to the state AFIS. With the finalization of upgrades for tenprint processing, our attention is now being turned to the upgrade for latent print processing.

The implementation of this upgrade calls for remote site latent workstations to be upgraded and replaced with new equipment. Firewalls, routers, and phone lines should not need to be upgraded or replaced with this project; only the latent terminals. Agencies will be required to upgrade their workstations in order to maintain their current connections to DPS. To allow agencies a sufficient amount of time to make arrangements for purchasing and installing the new equipment, DPS will maintain a method for the current latent terminal to connect for as long as possible. At this time, there is not a definite termination date for the current system, but that information will be sent out as soon as it is available.

Please take a moment to review the enclosed information sheet, and make sure that the information on file for your agency is accurate. It is imperative that contacts, phone numbers, and email addresses are up to date, so communication of additional information can be sent to the agencies in a timely and efficient manner.

Agencies desiring to upgrade their workstation should begin making plans to do so. Purchasing and installation information for the new equipment can be obtained from NEC Corporation America, by contacting either Vishnu Gangumalla or Tony Fehr. Their contact information is:
