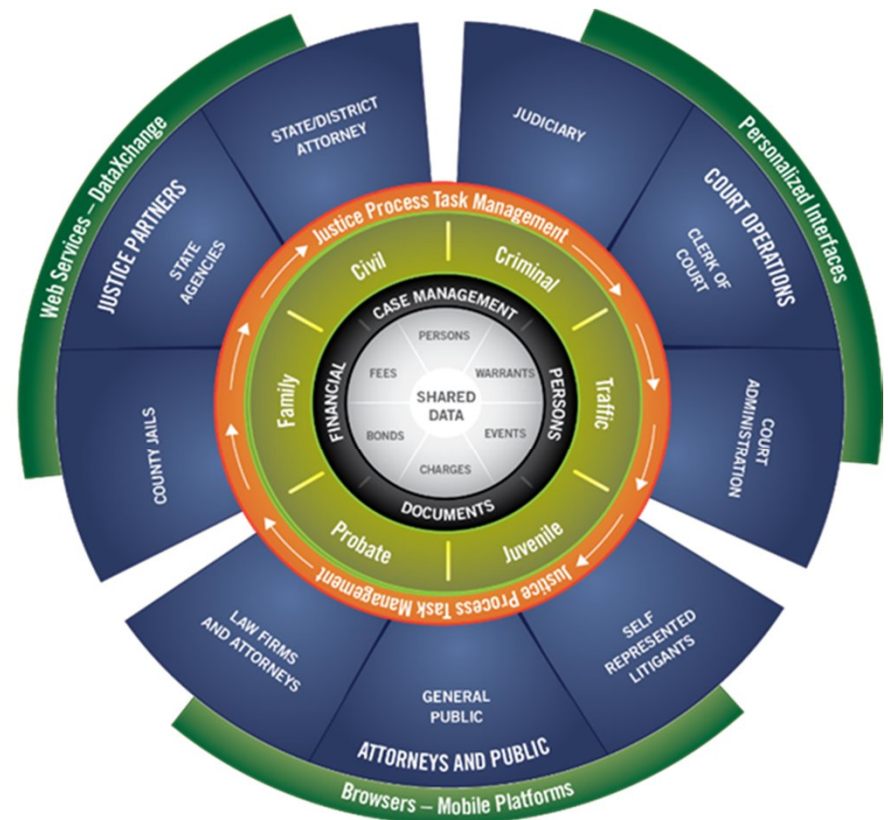

REDUCE DUPLICATE DATA ENTRY

The CSCD office creates approximately 330 cases each month with felony cases taking an average of 20 minutes and misdemeanor 15 minutes to create. Each of these cases require the data entry clerks to manually re-enter case data that already exists in Odyssey Case Manager. The integration of Odyssey Supervision will allow each product center to share this party data, dramatically reducing the requirement for duplicate data entry.

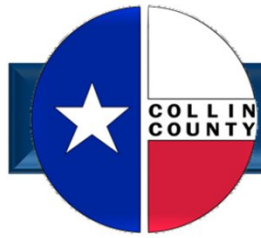


BENEFITS

WORKFLOW BETWEEN COURTS AND PROBATION OFFICES

Now that e-filing has been mandated for all criminal cases, all documents filed with the Court must be e-filed to the Clerk's office via eFile Texas. In order for the District Attorney's Office to receive motions electronically, the Supervision Officer is currently required to merge the form from the current solution, save to their local hard drive, and then email or interoffice mail to the DA's Office, which forces the District Attorney's Office to utilize a workaround in order to be compliant with the mandate.

Odyssey Supervision allows for complete integration with Odyssey Attorney Manager, which will allow the District Attorney's Office to annotate all documents in the case management system prior to e-filing. Annotations are shared across all product centers. Therefore, CSCD will always have the most current copy of motions filed with the Court.

TRANSITION FROM PAPER DOCUMENTS TO ELECTRONIC

The following is a list of documents currently delivered/received in paper form that will transition to electronic documents – furthering Collin County’s paperless initiative:

- Amended Conditions
- Notice of Violation
- Order Discharging
- Review/Consideration for Early Termination
- Motion to Revoke/Motion to Adjudicate
- Probation Orders
- Payment Plans
- Miscellaneous Correspondence

ELECTRONIC FINGERPRINTS

All amended orders require a fingerprint from the defendant. Therefore, the supervision officers are currently required to produce a paper document from one that is already in electronic format for the purpose of capturing a fingerprint. Odyssey Supervision has the functionality to capture fingerprints and signatures electronically – thus, further satisfying Collin County's paperless initiative.
