- Convenient and inexpensive subscription service to access over \$20 million worth of high quality aerial imagery for Texas;
- 6-inch pixel high resolution, natural color imagery from Google that can be used in your GIS or online map applications;
- Continuous and automatic imagery refresh cycles that provide updated imagery every three years, sooner for many urban areas;
- Access to metadata to better understand when the imagery was acquired;
- Google Cloud Platform (GCP) infrastructure that guarantees reliable and instant access to imagery and eliminates local data storage and management costs; and
- Continued access to older versions of Google imagery as new imagery becomes available.

As we approach the end of the pilot period on August 31, 2017, the service will continue to be available through an annual paid subscription.

Annual usage was calculated this year to determine final pricing for your agency for the September 1, 2017 – August 31, 2018 subscription period. The final annual cost is \$6,000.

Your agency will receive an invoice from the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) by October 20, 2017.
